Panama City Rescue Mission men's campus, 609 Allen Ave., Bethel Village women's campus 1313 E. 11th St. Application is for remodeling of downtown facility & building of 3rd location.

PCRM is a non-profit. Goal is rescue, recovery, restoring men, women & their families. We offer shelter, 5 day & longer for recovery. Clients cooperation & willingness can lead to a 12 month work related recovery program. Following this program PCRM graduates have 60-80% success rate. Short term secular programs rate is 8%. We had 14 graduates in 2017. Total of 57 clients found permanent jobs 2017. PCRM provided 29,927 nights of shelter in 2017.

Project One:

Triumph Gulf Coast funds would allow for new residency for men in recovery.

Rescue & recovery clients all congregate & reside at PCRM downtown. This is bad & opens the door for recovery clientele relapse. They need separation from temptations they face daily. We need land & new facility or purchase existing property to remodel. Moving all recovery to new facility will enable downtown to become 100% rescue! This helps the many issues of very transient downtown population. Homelessness, addiction to drugs, alcohol & the challenges of other behaviors largely exist in Bay County. They are displaced from family & usually out of the workforce. We can help this with the addition of 3rd location!

Project Two:

Triumph Gulf Coast funds would allow remodeling of downtown campus which was built 1980.

1. Kitchen needs refrigerator, freezer, double oven, stove, dishwashing system & serving equipment. Meals served 2017 totaled 108k for rescue & recovery.
2. Dormitory needs tile flooring, painting & bedding. Washrooms need additional showers, vanities & such.
3. Roof has existing leaks needs recovering.
3. Building needs security system / doors for after hours. The exterior & entrances for rescue & recovery need painting / upgrading.
4. We need 2 passenger vans.
5. We hope to acquire the adjacent home if came available. It is collection of the wrong people.

Funding summary for total estimate need of \$3 million.

- 1. This will include new 3rd location for recovery facility & 2 yr. operational cost.***
- 2. Will provide for remodeling of downtown facility as explained.***
