August 1, 2019-October 31, 2019

Project Progress:

Specifications for the necessary retrofit to the facility have been received. The bid process will soon be initiated.

Students have constructed grinder stands, vise stands, chopsaw table, cutting table, A-frame storage rack for steel and angle iron, storage rack for plate and expanded metal, and 1 helmet racks.

Progress Towards Metrics:

Thirty-five students began coursework on August 12, 2019:

- Welding Fundamentals 1 = 20
- Welding Technologies 1 = 1
- Welding Technologies 2 = 9
- Welding Technologies 3 = 4
- Welding Technologies 4 = 1

As of October 31, 2019, students have completed approximately 45 hours of instruction toward the 377.5 hours required for industry certification. Eighteen new students in grades 9-11 have been registered in the NCCER testing system.

The first grading period ended on October 11, 2019. Two students have below average grades.
