

SUMMARY
OF
FIRST AMENDMENT TO
GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TRIUMPH GULF COAST, INC.
AND
WAKULLA COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD (Project #198)

This summarizes the basic terms of a First Amendment to Grant Award Agreement (the “**Amendment**”) that has been negotiated between the staffs of Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc. (“**Triumph**”) and Walton County School Board (“**WCSB**”) under the Triumph Gulf Coast Trust Fund with respect to that certain Grant Award Agreement dated October 21, 2019, between WCSB and Triumph (the “**Agreement**”). This summary is intended for notice purposes only and does not create any binding obligations on Triumph or WCSB with respect to (i) any amendments to the Agreement, or (ii) engaging in any further discussions or negotiations with respect to any amendments to the Agreement. The final terms and conditions of any amendment will be contained in the definitive Amendment approved by the Board of Directors of Triumph and WCSB and executed by Triumph and WCSB.

AMENDMENTS TO
BUDGET CATEGORIES
AND FUNDING
PROCEDURES:

The total amount of the Grant is not changing; however, the allocation of Grant funds among the various budget categories is changing. Also, the Grant funding procedures are being amended to include a reference to Triumph’s SmartSheet system and to incorporate Triumph’s updated form of Request for Funding. Accordingly, the Agreement is being amended as follows:

1. The “WHEREAS” recital on page 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“WHEREAS, pursuant to its authority under **Section 288.8017, Florida Statutes**, Triumph has agreed to make a Grant (as defined below) to WCSB, on and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, to provide partial funding for the following projects in connection with WCSB’s Unmanned Aircraft Systems/Visual Line of Sight Operations Program (collectively, the “**Project**”): (i) salaries (“**Salaries**”), (ii) equipment (“**Equipment**”), (iii) teacher training (“**Training**”), (iv) consumables and other student supplies (“**Supplies**”),

and (v) certification fees (“**Fees**”), all as further described in WCSB’s Application for Funds submitted to Triumph (the “**Grant Application**”), which Grant Application is incorporated herein by reference.

2. Section 4 of the Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:

“4. Funding of Grant:

4.1 **Funding.** As more fully shown in the Budget (as defined in Section 5.2 below), the Grant shall be allocated as follows:

a) \$600,000 of the Grant funds shall be allocated for Salaries, to be funded in the amounts and at the times as set forth in the Budget;

b) \$1,060,000 of the Grant funds shall be allocated for Equipment and Supplies, to be funded in the amounts and at the times as set forth in the Budget; and

c) \$120,000 of the Grant funds shall be allocated for Training, Curriculum, and Fees, to be funded in the amounts and at the times as set forth in the Budget; and

4.2 Conditions to Funding of the Grant. As used in the Budget, Year 1 shall mean the calendar year 2020; Year 2 shall mean the calendar year 2021; Year 3 shall mean the calendar year 2022; Year 4 shall mean the calendar year 2023; Year 5 shall mean the calendar year 2024; Year 6 shall mean the calendar year 2025; and Year 7 shall mean the calendar year 2026. On or before November 1 of each calendar year, WCSB shall submit to Triumph a Request for Funding on the form attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** and incorporated herein (a “**Request for Funding**”) for the next calendar Year together with information pursuant to a SmartSheet system by WCSB’s authorized users listed in **Exhibit “C”** attached hereto and incorporated herein. Each Request for Funding shall include (A) reports in Budget categories with copies of general ledger detail for the Project account (as defined below) showing itemized expenditures, (B) invoices from architects, engineers, contractors, materialmen, and other vendors performing the construction; (C) invoices, purchase orders, or contracts from vendors providing equipment, materials, and services; (D) payroll ledgers, state and federal payroll returns, and other employment data, (E) documentation evidencing the completion of the work that is the subject of the requested funding, (F) to the extent that any portion of the current funding request is for reimbursement of amounts already paid by WCSB, copies of cancelled checks evidencing that WCSB paid vendors, (G) evidence of payment and use of Matching Funds (as defined below), and (H) such other documents as Triumph shall require in order to determine that the funding is consistent with the purposes of the Grant. WCSB shall notify the Triumph Program Administrator via email each time a Request for Funding is submitted. Each

Request for Funding shall aggregate not less than \$50,000 of eligible funding items. Upon Triumph's receipt of (a) notification to the Program Administrator, and (b) a Request for Funding that includes all required supporting documents, Triumph shall have forty-five (45) days from receipt to review and either approve or disapprove of a Request for Funding. If Triumph approves a Request for Funding, then it shall fund the approved amount to WCSB within thirty (30) days after approval. If Triumph disapproves a Request for Funding, Triumph shall deliver a notice of disapproval within such forty-five (45) day period that states the reasons for such disapproval. If the stated reasons for disapproval can be cured by WCSB's submittal of missing or corrective items, WCSB shall have thirty (30) days following receipt of the notice of disapproval to submit such missing or corrective items. If Triumph fails to notify WCSB of its disapproval of the Request for Funding within forty-five (45) days of receipt, such Request for Funding shall be deemed disapproved.

All amounts funded to WCSB pursuant to a Request for Funding shall be (check as applicable):

_____ paid to WCSB as a disbursement, in which case WCSB shall then pay vendors supplying equipment, materials, or services, and/or to employees performing work, in each case consistent with the Budget; or

 X paid to WCSB as a reimbursement of amounts WCSB has already paid to vendors supplying equipment, materials, or services, and/or to employees performing work, in each case consistent with the Budget, in which case the Grant funds shall be retained by WCSB.

None of the Grant shall be used as a reimbursement of items purchased by WCSB prior to the date of this Agreement. None of the amounts paid by WCSB in connection with the invoices submitted in a Request for Funding and then funded by Triumph shall also have been or will in the future be in any manner (a) reimbursed, returned, refunded, rebated, or otherwise credited to, WCSB by any contractor, materialman, vendor, or any other person or entity, or (b) paid, reimbursed, returned, refunded, rebated, or otherwise credited to WCSB by the State of Florida, the United States, or any agency or instrumentality of any of the foregoing, whether under any grant or loan program or other method of contribution, it being expressly understood and agreed that WCSB shall not receive payments, refunds, reimbursements, rebates or credits from any sources in amounts collectively exceeding 100% of the amounts paid or owing by WCSB.

WCSB shall seek funding only for costs as shown or contemplated under the Budget. All amounts paid by WCSB with respect to the Project shall be supported by properly executed invoices, contracts, or vouchers evidencing in proper detail the nature and propriety of the charges. Any check or order drawn by WCSB with respect to any item which is or will be chargeable against the Project account will be drawn only in accordance with a properly signed voucher then on file in the office of WCSB stating in proper detail the purpose for which such check or order is drawn. All checks, invoices, contracts, vouchers, orders, or other accounting documents pertaining in whole or in part to the Project shall be

clearly identified, readily accessible, and, to the extent feasible, kept separate and apart from all other such documents.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Triumph shall not be obligated to make the final disbursement of the Grant until WCSB provides satisfactory evidence that WCSB has properly and fully expended all Matching Funds.

Triumph will honor requests for funding; provided, however, that Triumph may elect by notice in writing not to make a payment if:

- (a) There is missing or incomplete documentation;
- (b) The Request for Funding seeks funding for items other than as described above or as shown in the Budget;
- (c) The amount requested for funding under the Request for Funding, together with all amounts previously funded under the Grant, would exceed the \$1,780,000 maximum amount of the Grant; or the amount requested for funding under the Request for Funding for a particular Budget category, together with all amounts previously funded for such Budget category, would exceed the maximum amount allocated to such Budget category; or WCSB failed to use any Grant funds funded to date in the amounts and for the purposes stated in the Budget;
- (d) WCSB made a misrepresentation or omission of a material nature in the Grant Application, or any supplement or amendment to the Grant Application, or with respect to any document or data furnished with the Grant Application or pursuant to this Agreement;
- (e) There is any pending litigation with respect to the performance by WCSB of any of its duties or obligations which may jeopardize or adversely affect the Project, this Agreement, or funding of the Grant;
- (f) WCSB has taken any action pertaining to the Project which, under this Agreement, requires the approval of Triumph, and WCSB failed to obtain such approval;
- (g) There has been a violation of Sections 9.1, 9.4, and/or 9.5 of this Agreement;
- (h) WCSB is in material violation, default, or breach of or under any provision of this Agreement;
- (i) WCSB is in breach of any material representation or warranty contained in this Agreement;

- (j) Any federal, state, or local organization or agency (including WCSB) providing financial assistance to the Project has revoked, suspended, or terminated that financial assistance to the Project, including, but not limited to, the Matching Funds;
- (k) The Matching Funds are not being used for the intended purposes and in the amounts and at the times as set forth in a schedule of expenses approved by Triumph, and/or WCSB has failed to provide Triumph with evidence of payment of the Matching Funds toward completion of the Project;
- (l) With respect to previous fundings of the Grant and payments under Contracts, WCSB has failed to pay, or has failed to provide Triumph with evidence of payment of, the Grant for the purposes of such funding. Such evidence shall include, but not be limited to, payroll ledgers, state and federal payroll returns, job descriptions, cancelled checks, wire transfer confirmations;
- (m) Prior to the Completion Deadline (as defined in Section 5.1 below), WCSB has abandoned or discontinued the Project, or for any reason the commencement, prosecution, or timely completion of the Project by WCSB is rendered improbable, infeasible, impossible, or illegal;
- (n) All or any portion of the requested funding includes funding for items that are outside the scope of the Project that is contemplated under the Budget;
- (o) One or more of the Contracts previously approved or deemed approved by Triumph have been modified, amended, or terminated, or have been subject to a change order, without the prior written consent or deemed approval of Triumph; provided, however, that any change order under \$5,000 shall not be subject to approval under this Agreement;
- (p) WCSB shall have annually failed to make reasonable good faith efforts to obtain Business Donations in accordance with Section 5.12 below, and/or shall have failed to provide Triumph with satisfactory evidence of such efforts. Such evidence shall include a spreadsheet listing the Business Donations, the donors, and WCSB's determination of the fair market value of the Business Donations, together with the latest sample form of letter or other communication requesting such Business Donation;
- (q) A Budget category has been increased or decreased by more than 5%;
- (r) Completion of the Project is not on schedule for completion by the Completion Deadline;
- (s) WCSB has failed to maintain in full force and effect all insurance required under Sections 5.4 and 5.10 below;
- (t) WCSB is not in compliance with all applicable environmental laws and regulations in accordance with Section 5.5 below;
- (u) WCSB is not in compliance with the competitive bidding requirements set forth in Section 3 above; and/or

(v) WCSB is not in compliance with the equal employment opportunity and other labor provisions as required by Section 9.3 below.”

3. The first sentence of Section 5.2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“The total cost of the Project is \$2,107,135, of which (i) WCSB shall pay \$327,135 toward salaries and benefits over a seven (7) year period as shown in the Budget (collectively, the “**Matching Funds**”), and (ii) \$1,780,000 shall be provided by the Grant.”

AMENDMENTS
TO EXHIBITS:

The form of Application for Disbursement attached to the Agreement as Exhibit “A” is being deleted and replaced with the form of Request for Funding attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, and all references in the Agreement to an Application for Disbursement shall hereafter mean and refer to a Request for Funding. The Budget attached to the Agreement as Exhibit “B” is being deleted and replaced with the form of Budget/Timeline attached hereto as Exhibit “B”, and all references in the Agreement to the Budget shall hereafter mean and refer to the Budget attached hereto. The SmartSheet authorized users referenced in Section 4.2 of the Agreement are listed in **Exhibit “C”** attached hereto, which Exhibit “C” shall be deemed added to and incorporated into the Agreement as Exhibit “C” thereto.
