# Program Administrator Report Triumph Gulf Coast Board Meeting May 19, 2021

The Triumph Gulf Coast staff continues regular work with grantees on the implementation of 39 active projects, with two projects completed, totaling over \$257,000,000. Staff monitors and reviews projects for compliance and processes requests for funds on an ongoing basis, and continues to work with applicants and potential applicants, to review pre-applications, applications and to negotiate agreements.

Staff has concluded its monitoring Legislative Committee meetings and floor actions that may have had impacts on the operations of the organization during the 2021 Legislative Session.

#### **Pre-Applications**

As of Friday May 14, Triumph Gulf Coast had received 247 Pre-Applications totaling \$1,832,965,702 in requests. Two Pre-Applications were received between April 16, 2021 and May 14, 2021.

Staff recommends Pre-Application 248 as ineligible and 249 as eligible.
