SUMMARY OF

SECOND AMENDMENT TO GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

TRIUMPH GULF COAST, INC.

AND

NORTHWEST FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE

(Project #187)

This summarizes the basic terms of a Second Amendment to Grant Award Agreement (the "Amendment") that has been negotiated between the staffs of Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc. ("Triumph") and Northwest Florida State College, a Florida College System institution as a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("NWFSC") and does not constitute an increase to any existing grant, or an approval to increase an existing grant, by Triumph to NWFSC, and (b) does not create any binding obligations on Triumph or NWFSC with respect to (i) any increase of any existing grant, (ii) any approval of an amendment to an existing grant, or (iii) engaging in any further discussions or negotiations with respect to any amendments to any existing grant. The final terms and conditions of the proposed amendments to the existing grant will be contained in the definitive Amendment approved by the Board of Directors of Triumph and NWFSC and executed by Triumph and NWFSC.

EXISTING GRANT AWARD

AGREEMENT:

That certain Grant Award Agreement dated August 16, 2019, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Grant Award Agreement dated May 5, 2020 (as amended, the "**Agreement**").

PURPOSE OF AMENDMENTS:

- (1) **Increase Grant Amount**. The Grant amount is increased by \$92,500
- (2) Additional Project. An additional project (the "Pilot Project") is added whereby NWFSC will develop a pilot program to offer short-term, non-credit training that will equip individuals with the skills they need for cloud based computing training and certifications. The Pilot Project will issue a minimum of 25 cloud based industry certifications earned in non-credit short-term trainings over the course of one year ("Certificates"). NWFSC will integrate Amazon Web Services (AWS) and other curriculum into the NWFSC learning management system (LMS) to develop self-paced training courses that lead to certifications.
- (3) **Total Cost/Budget**. The total cost of the Pilot Project is \$185,000, as more fully shown in the following budget (the "**Pilot Project Budget**"), with the Grant providing \$92,500 of that amount and NWFSC providing \$92,500 of that amount (the "**Pilot Project Matching Funds**"):

The Budget attached as Exhibit "B" to the Agreement is deleted and replaced with the Budget attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein, which incorporates the Pilot Project Budget. All references to the Budget in the Agreement shall hereafter mean and refer to the Budget attached hereto as Exhibit "B."

- (5) **Performance Metrics**. All Pilot Project Grant Funds disbursed by Triumph to NWFSC shall be subject to being repaid ("clawed back") in the event (i) NWFSC abandons, suspends or discontinues the Pilot Project, or fails to complete the Pilot Project by December 31, 2023; and/or (ii) NWFSC made any materially false certification or representation to Triumph in connection with its application for the Pilot Project Grant Funds, and/or in connection with any request for reimbursement; and/or (iii) NWFSC breaches any obligation under the Agreement. In addition, if NWFSC fails to award a cumulative total of at least 25 Certificates by the December 31, 2023, then NWFSC shall upon written demand by Triumph repay to Triumph a claw back amount equal to (A) \$3,700, multiplied by (B) the sum of (1) 25 minus (2) the actual number of Certificates issued as of December 31, 2023. In no event shall the total amount paid by NWFSC to Triumph under this Section 4 exceed \$92,500.
- **(6) Compliance With Other Terms of Agreement**. Sections 4.2, 5. −5.11, 7.1 − 7.3 of the Agreement shall be applied to the Pilot Project, the Pilot Project Grant Funds the Pilot Project Budget, and the Pilot Project Matching Funds.
