Florida State University Panama City (FSU PC) has submitted a request for funding to create a new Collegiate Laboratory High School in Bay County to serve grades 9-12. This school, expected to open Fall 2023, will serve approximately 125 students per grade level and will give admission preference to dependents of active-duty military. The school will by the first of its kind for Bay County, only the 8th lab school in the state, and will extend the benefits of having a local, top 20 university to families of high school-aged children in our area.

Students who attend the school will have the unique opportunities to earn industry certifications, complete dual enrollment coursework aligned with their intended majors, and conduct an age-appropriate research project under the mentorship of FSU faculty all while attending high school.

A high performing lab school, particularly one with degree acceleration opportunities and affiliation with a top 20 University, will add to the list of key assets for Bay County's economic growth. With immersion opportunities in high-wage, high-demand fields, such as engineering, computer science, information technology, and health sciences, students will be prepared to fill needed workforce gaps at an accelerated rate while saving their families thousands of dollars.
