RE: Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc. Semi-Annual Report January 2022 – June 2022

Dear Governor DeSantis, President Simpson, and Speaker Sprowls:

Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc. was originally created in statute in 2013 and received its first funding from the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill Settlement in 2017. In the ensuing years, Triumph Gulf Coast has become one of the most successful and effective economic development engines in Florida history. As the stewards of \$1.5 billion awarded to Florida by the federal court for economic damages caused by the oil spill, Triumph Gulf Coast's statutory mission is to strengthen and diversify the economy of coastal Northwest Florida through job creation, workforce development and public infrastructure.

Since its first grant award of \$10 million in 2018 to expand the Port of Panama City, Triumph has awarded more than \$361 million to 52 projects in all eight counties disproportionately affected by the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill. Because of its vetting and selecting of well-conceived projects, attracting 2+ to 1 matching funds, and requiring strict

performance contracts with enforceable clawbacks, Triumph was described as "...a model of efficiency and effectiveness...." by the James Madison Institute. (See attached Fox Business News Editorial by Bob McClure, President and CEO, James Madison Institute, published on May 18, 2020.)

The highly respected business and governmental economist, Dr. Rick Harper, reports that every \$1 awarded by Triumph is creating \$19 in beneficial economic growth for Northwest Florida, an extraordinary return on investment.

With less than a third of Triumph's total corpus committed and more than \$1 billion remaining to be awarded, Triumph's milestones to date already include:

- More than \$229 million in infrastructure investments including expansions of two seaports, a major bypass to support military missions, a maritime industrial park making possible as much as \$10.3 billion in Coast Guard construction, outside the gate airfield expansion to substantially expand Naval support missions, three industrial parks across the Highways 90 and 10 corridors with a majority of sites already committed. Job creation projects include an aircraft maintenance-repair-overhaul campus with international partners and customers, electrical transformer manufacturing, pharmaceutical and medical device manufacturing, marine manufacturing, and multiple logistics and distribution facilities.
- \$105.6 million in education workforce training including facilities and faculty for airframe, aircraft maintenance and pilot training, a joint venture with the University of Florida and a local school district for artificial intelligence instruction, a Florida State University STEM lab school supporting the post-Michael rebuild of Tyndall Air Force Base, four Unmanned Systems drone training programs linked to K-12 school districts, near-doubling of nursing education in the eastern portion of the Triumph region, Career Technical Education (CTE) training in welding, pipefitting, carpentry, construction and industrial trades, HVAC, agriculture sciences, emergency management, fire sciences, health care services, information technology, commercial driving licenses, and engineering/design sponsored by seven K-12 districts, two universities, four state colleges and a county sheriff's office.
- \$8 million in Triumph sponsored research to restore the aquaculture of Florida's legendary Apalachicola oyster beds. This funding has induced federal and state research grants of over \$20 million.
- \$19 million in ad valorem tax benefits to assist local governments in covering emergency post-hurricane costs and support counties in attracting private jobcreation industry
- Of the \$106 million in education and workforce training, more than \$41 million is in programs with a primary focus in cybersecurity and IT training with education partners for Northwest Florida residents, active-duty military families, and separating uniformed military to qualify them for high-skill, high-wage jobs in Northwest Florida.

The net effects of those milestones include:

- 16,273 net new jobs, with all incentivized jobs paying 115% or more of the prevailing wages in the area
- 29,977 national industry certifications or milestones earned by K-12, college, and university, retiring military and military spouses in the very occupational categories most needed in our coastal economy
- More than \$800 million in net new family income annually
- Uncommon risk-sharing by attracting almost \$800 million in matching funds, attracting private and public sector partners as full investors in every project
- A regional economy more diversified, resilient, and self-reliant than at any other time in our area's history

A highly unusual feature of Triumph's operation is the strict, objective, measurable performance metrics applied to every project. Binding contracts with qualified applicants and partners ensure that Triumph can reclaim funds in all cases if metrics aren't achieved. When hurricanes and pandemic conditions justified flexibility, the Triumph board renegotiated with a few applicants. But, to date, not one of the funded projects have been cited for non-performance nor have any funds had to be clawed back.

Triumph has provided extensive hands-on help to applicants to qualify for funding, evaluated every proposal with due diligence, return on investment and job-creation viability prior to every award and managed and monitored every project for contract compliance and faithful performance. These functions are carried out by Executive Director Susan Skelton, Program Administrator Cori Henderson, Economic Advisor Dr. Rick Harper, Education/Workforce Advisor Dr. Frank Fuller, and Construction Compliance Advisor Randy Lewis, AIA, together with the accounting firm of Tipton, Marler, Garner and Chastain, and the Clark Partington law firm.

Total operational costs – including financial management, legal services, and research – have cost less than ¾ of 1 percent of Triumph funds, a nearly unprecedented record for low overhead and financial stewardship. The 2022 legislative session agreed that \$5 million of interest earned by Triumph on its unexpended funds could be used for project management and compliance over the remaining 11 years of the organization's intended life.

Triumph Gulf Coast is independently audited by outside auditors and is examined and audited annually by the Auditor General of Florida. Not once in its existence has Triumph been cited or criticized by any auditor or oversight body.

This spring Triumph Gulf Coast's original directors have completed their terms, which, by law, cannot be extended. Directors who have served since the organization's inception, and their appointing authorities, are:

In coronavirus crisis lessons for recovery from the Gulf Coast's Deepwater Horizon disaster



Last month a ten-year anniversary passed with little notice. On April 20, 2010, the Deepwater Horizon offshore <u>oil platform</u> suffered an explosion that resulted in the largest marine oil spill in history.

Over the next several weeks, close to five million barrels (approximately 210 million gallons) of oil seeped out into the Gulf of Mexico.

The consequences of the event are largely considered the greatest environmental

catastrophe in U.S. history and an <u>economic disaster</u> for the communities along the panhandle of Florida through Alabama and Mississippi.

Economically, the cost to the Gulf coast was estimated in the tens of billions of dollars.

There is an important lesson from that disaster that could offer a novel approach to the economic challenges ahead of us today.

In response to the Deepwater Horizon crisis, the State of Florida established Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc. – a nonprofit designed solely to administer Florida's portion of the relief funds.

The Triumph board was appointed by elected leaders at the state level to oversee the collection and distribution of funds for the recovery, diversification, and enhancement of the eight Florida counties impacted.

In the years since its formation, Triumph Gulf Coast has distributed close to \$250 million in relief directly to affected businesses and communities – and has done so as a model of efficiency and effectiveness.

In response to the COVID-19 economic lockdowns established in almost all states, our national economy has gone from a Ferrari to a seized engine in just a few short weeks.

The national unemployment rate of 3.5 percent (a 50-year low) jumped to 4.4 percent in March and then 14.7 percent in April, meaning 20.5 million Americans lost their jobs in April alone.

The economic fall-out is prompting discussions about a "Great Depression 2.0" by summer. And the federal government, seeking to do whatever it can to design relief packages, is proving once again to be as inefficient, ineffective, and special-interest-pandering as its 11 percent approval rating would suggest.

We've added more than \$2 trillion to our national debt, and the trajectory has us on course to spend another \$2 trillion before the year is out.

The next phase of economic relief may well include up to \$500 billion to states to help address revenue shortfalls. More direct relief to businesses and individuals may also be in the future.

Those boards should possess the authority and accountability to determine the most

valuable methods, channels, and strategies for using federal aid dollars.

While many conservatives may question the merits of more federal debt in the form of cash to states, the reality is there is zero chance Congress won't authorize more spending.

Let's ensure the money is spent in a way that maximizes value and targets direct and specific needs. Let's face it -- each state is unique – in demographics, governing structures, and economic conditions.

The best use of \$5 billion dollars will look quite different in New York than it will in New Mexico. How a small business grant program works in Colorado should probably be structured and function differently than it would in Connecticut.

In a state like Illinois, with substantial fiscal challenges, CARES Act funds may need to be allocated to social programs in urban centers more than in a state like New Hampshire, which doesn't have the same fiscal conditions.

As we confront this fiscal shock, our leaders should apply the lessons from Deepwater. Adopting the approach Florida took 10 years ago to combat a previous crisis, we can ensure that future relief monies are used in the best possible manner, while minimizing inefficiencies and the fraud or misuse that the federal government can't seem to eliminate (we're looking at you Kennedy Center).

Between now and the end of May, each state should work to establish its own "COVID-19 Economic Recovery Inc" nonprofit, with a board made up of a cross-section of policymakers, local officials, business leaders, and community stakeholders.

Some may make the case, not unreasonably, that the state legislature should control this money, since they are elected by the people to create a budget and this is part of that function. But in many states, public-private partnerships have proven to be of tremendous value in addressing specific challenges.

The concept of mobilizing the business community, in concert with partners in state and local government and community leaders, has the potential to not only ensure that future relief funds are channeled in the most valuable manner, but also to generate new avenues for resources.

Throughout our 233-year history as a constitutional republic, citizens have shown up when called. Let the states tap into their resources to make the economic recovery as

powerful as it can be.

- (3) Monitor, review, and annually evaluate awardees and their projects or programs to determine whether an award should be continued, terminated, reduced, or increased.

Staff recommended to continue to fund the following grant:

For deliverable 1, "Assess temporal and spatial changes in oyster communities in Franklin County," the FSUCML team has examined and characterized reports and obtained access to GIS. Item 2 is "construct a pilot-scale oyster hatchery." TGC score progress on these first two deliverables as acceptable given the constraints imposed by Covid. Item 3 "bio-physical modeling," where an appropriately qualified consultant has been retained and a contract entered into, and Deliverable 4, "monitoring of oyster communities and their environment," were scored by TGC staff score as having made good progress. Deliverable 5 is "oyster population genetic structure," which was only scheduled to begin in the last quarter of the first project year. It is behind schedule because of the severe depletion of subtidal oysters in Apalachicola Bay. It is hoped that the spring spawn may generate sufficient numbers of juveniles this summer to conduct the study, so that the new target start date is summer 2020. TGC staff score deliverable 5 progress as good. Deliverable 9 is "targeted outreach to community," which entails development of a community advisory board, and other activities. The project awarded a two-year contract to the Florida Conflict Resolution Consortium (FCRC) in May 2019 and it has begun its work.

In total, progress on the ABSI project is good, and recommended to be continued.
