Program Administrator Report Triumph Gulf Coast Board Meeting March 31, 2023

The Triumph Gulf Coast staff continues regular work with grantees on the implementation of 47 active projects, with an additional eight projects completed, totaling over \$403,000,000. Staff monitors and reviews projects for compliance and processes requests for funds on an ongoing basis, and continues to work with applicants and potential applicants, to review pre-applications, applications and to negotiate agreements.

As of Thursday, March 23, 2023, there were 11 current applications available for staff review and an additional 13 active pre-applications that have not yet submitted applications.

Pre-Applications

As of Thursday, March 23, 2023, Triumph Gulf Coast had received 298 Pre-Applications totaling over \$2,349,122,000 in requests.

Pre-applications 297, 298, 299, and 300 are recommended as statutorily eligible. Pre-application 292 is recommended as not statutorily eligible. *Staff recommendation of statutory eligibility does not guarantee grant funding.*

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Construction, Contract Compliance, and Term Sheet Review for Triumph G.C. Board Meeting March 31, 2023.

The following items reflect contract, construction, quarterly reporting, proposed grant term sheet review, and comment activity since January 26, 2023. This report is for the March 31, 2023, Triumph Gulf Coast Board Meeting.

#43 Okaloosa County Hwy 90 Water and Sewer Extension

 I reviewed the 2022 4th Quarter Progress Report, Oct.- Dec. 2022, for the Okaloosa County Hwy 90 East Water and Sewer Expansion. Design and construction of the original grant scope of work was completed June 30, 2021. The engineering design documents are 30% complete for extension of the water and sewer as part of the Grant Amendment. The quarterly report appears complete and acceptable to Triumph G.C.

#48 Wakulla County Emergency Communications System

- I reviewed the following: 1.) RFQ Proposal package, 2.) RFQ Instructions to proposers, 3.) RFQ Intent And General Information, 4.) Wakulla County Purchasing Ordinance, 5.) Submitted RFQ/PQS Proposal Packages, 6.) Evaluation of PQS Proposal Packages, 7.) RFQ/PQS Total Scores/Ranking, and 8.) Proposed Contract For Professional Consulting Services between TUSA Consulting Services and Wakulla County. I asked Grantee to revise the Contract for Professional Consulting Services to include a Statement of Purpose (basic intent) and a General Scope Statement to include TUSA Consulting Services will provide oversight of the installation of a countywide emergency radio system.
- County Attorney asked for a revision on the language based on the agreement between Wakulla County and Triumph Gulf Coast (Section 3). TUSA is not providing Construction Engineering & Inspection (CEI) however they will oversee the construction and installation of the communications system. I requested Grantee to clarify who is designing and engineering the Emergency Communications System. "The Kickoff Meeting and Critical Design Review" in TUSA proposal includes "The detail design review is to start reviewing the components of the system and preliminary engineering documents."
- I reviewed the revised Contract for Professional Consulting Services between TUSA Consulting Services and Wakulla County, including general scope statements that the TUSA Consulting Services will provide oversight of construction and installation of a

countywide emergency radio system. The Contract for Professional Consulting Services appears to comply Triumph G.C. Grant guidelines and requirements.

- I reviewed the proposed Construction and Installation Agreement between Wakulla County and Motorola. I noted that "Section 36. Exhibits Incorporated" in the agreement should include The Triumph Gulf Coast Grant. The Triumph Gulf Coast Grant shall also be incorporated into the TUSA agreement as an Exhibit. The "Post Warranty Maintenance and Support" budget line items in the Agreement "Proposal Price Summary" appear to far exceed the Total Project Budget Line Items for years 6-15 defined in the Triumph Grant. Grantee explained the county will use legally available funds to pay for the future maintenance costs and additional project costs.
- I reviewed the revised proposed Construction and Installation Agreement between Wakulla County and Motorola, uploaded to Smartsheet March 7. The Agreement appears acceptable to Triumph G.C. with the understanding and commitment that the county will use legally available funds to pay for the future maintenance costs which exceed grant funds and matching funds identified in the Grant.

#157 Franklin County School District and Apalachicola Bay Charter School New Technology Building

- I reviewed the RFQ advertisement and the PQS invitation, scope and qualifications forms in Smartsheet. The RFQ and advertisement are acceptable to Triumph G.C.
- The Grantee asked to execute an additional payment agreement between the District and the Charter School to fund the \$335,000 in the grant for this project. In this agreement the School District is asking ABC School to front the District the money in order to pay Rippee Construction Company for the building construction as the project progresses. Once the District has the money in hand from ABC the District will pay Rippee as the vendor. The district will submit monthly payment records including invoices, purchase order, and cleared checks to Triumph for reimbursement as allowed by the Grant. Then, once the District is reimbursed by Triumph, the District will reimburse the ABC School.
- The Grantee asked if Triumph might have any issues with this internal agreement affecting the reimbursement process on the construction of the computer lab to us from Triumph for this grant. I reviewed the agreement and <u>The Standard Form</u> of Agreement Between Owner and Construction Manager and responded that the internal agreement should be uploaded to Smartsheet for disclosure, as it does relate to the construction / contractor payment. <u>The Standard Form of Agreement Between</u> <u>Owner and Construction Manager</u> includes well developed additions to the contract, reflecting conditions of the Triumph Grant.

#185 Panama City Industrial Complex and Eastern Shipbuilding Group Project

- I reviewed the Contract Agreement between the City of Panama City and the Eastern Shipbuilding Group, and Marshall Brothers Construction and Engineering, Inc. for the Aluminum Fabrication Building Stormwater Improvements. The Contract Agreement complies with the grant conditions and requirements, and appears acceptable to Triumph G.C.
- I reviewed the executed Change Order #1 for replacement of missing materials for the Aluminum Fabrication Building Stormwater Improvements. The Change Order has been recommended by Anchor Engineering and accepted by the City of Panama City, Eastern Shipbuilding Group, and Marshall Brothers Construction and Engineering, Inc.. The Change Order is justified and necessary to complete the work, and appears acceptable to Triumph G.C.

#227 Panama City Port Authority's Intermodal Transportation Center

- I spoke with the Port about review team confusion with the payment request labeling not matching the Grant- IDC Phase II. I asked that they upload a brief narrative explaining why the work / invoicing is labeled IDC Site Preparation Phase VI to Smartsheets for clarification.
- I reviewed the McNeil Carroll Engineering Site Construction Progress Report #10, application for payment request #4, evaluation, recommendation, and commentary uploaded to Smartsheet. The construction activity reflected in the report appears to be all associated with the grant scope of work for Phase II, though labeled IDC Site Preparation Phase VI, based on the title of the McNeil Carroll Engineering Contract Documents for Construction. The IDC Site Preparation Phase I referenced in the First Amendment to The Grant Award Agreement, was completed prior to the grant and the McNeil Carroll Contract Documents for Construction for Construction were apparently titled Phase I, II, III, IV, and V.

191 APALACHICOLA REGIONAL AIRPORT FRANKLIN CO. FUEL FARM REPLACEMENT

• I reviewed the Advertisement for Bids to be opened Monday, March 20th, 2023, and I have again reviewed the contract document drawings prepared by AVCON, Inc. The Triumph Grant is not included in any bid documents; I asked Grantee to issue the Triumph Grant- the grant requirements and conditions in Addendum to attach to the Special Provisions section of the Manual during the bidding phase. This was previously requested October 5, 2022.

#207 GCSC Gulf / Franklin Nursing Simulation

• I reviewed the 4th Quarter Construction Progress Report and the 4th Quarter Narrative Report, Dec. 31, 2022. The new training modular buildings are complete and landscaping is installed. Remodel of Classrooms B-112 and D105 are complete and being utilized. Renovations to Building A for Nurse Training is complete, and the nursing program is scheduled to begin using the remodeled Building A for the Spring term beginning in January 2023. The Construction Progress Reports appear complete and thorough.

#209 SR Project Lionheart - Northwest Florida Industrial Park

• I reviewed the Q1-2023 Construction Progress Report for #209- NWFL I-10 Industrial Park dated Jan. 3, 2023. Site work construction is progressing, and the Report appears complete and acceptable to Triumph G.C.

#210 GCSC UAS Pilot Boot Camp for Exiting Military

 I reviewed the 4th Quarter Construction Progress Report and the 4th Quarter Narrative Report Dec. 31, 2022. The new training modular buildings are complete, and landscaping is installed. Remodel of Classrooms B-112 and D105 are complete and being utilized. Renovations to Building A for Nurse Training is complete, and the nursing program is scheduled to begin using the remodeled Building A for the Spring term beginning in January 2023 allowing the UVS program to utilize space in the modular buildings. The Construction Progress Reports appear complete and thorough.

#211 Pensacola State College Truck Driving School

• I have reviewed the Pensacola State College 4th Quarter Report (Oct. 2022- Dec. 2022) for the Commercial Vehicle Driving Program, the Architect's PSC Truck Driving School Substantial Completion Inspection List, the Engineer's substantial completion field inspection report, and the Architect's two Final Completion Inspection Lists. The truck driver training facility is complete and being used. The reports appear complete and acceptable to Triumph G.C.

#240 Santa Rosa Industrial Park East

- I reviewed the evaluation and recommendation for approval of the submitted Change Order #2 for the fencing upgrades by the engineer of record. Based on the recommendation for approval of the Change Order by the engineer of record, Triumph G.C. agrees with the fencing upgrades around the pond.
- Cori scheduled a conference call Feb.15, with Karen Spayd, Economic Development Grants Coordinator and Tina Stewart to discuss a Change Order for additional CEI service

and removal and permitting of gopher tortoises over \$325,000, and if they need Triumph approval to proceed. The CO was approved on the county level using county funds and not Triumph funds, they are match funds and technically don't need Triumph review/approval. I requested they upload the CO and county approval to Smartsheet so that we stay up to date on the project, and a quick review and approval can be done.
