

SUMMARY
OF
SECOND AMENDMENT TO
GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TRIUMPH GULF COAST, INC.
AND
WAKULLA COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD
(Project #29)

This summarizes the basic terms of a Second Amendment to Grant Award Agreement (the “**Amendment**”) that has been negotiated between the staffs of Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc. (“**Triumph**”) and the Wakulla County School Board (“**WCSB**”) under the Triumph Gulf Coast Trust Fund. This summary is intended for notice purposes only and (a) does not constitute an increase to any existing grant, or an approval to increase an existing grant, by Triumph to WCSB, and (b) does not create any binding obligations on Triumph or WCSB with respect to (i) any increase of any existing grant, (ii) any approval of an amendment to an existing grant, or (iii) engaging in any further discussions or negotiations with respect to any amendments to any existing grant. The final terms and conditions of the proposed amendments to the existing grant will be contained in the definitive Amendment approved by the Board of Directors of Triumph and WCSB and executed by Triumph and WCSB.

AGREEMENT: That that certain Grant Award Agreement dated July 23, 2018, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Grant Award Agreement dated January 28, 2020 (as amended, the “**Agreement**”).

PURPOSE OF
AMENDMENTS:

To remove Performance Metric #3 from Section 7.3 of the Agreement. Paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Section 7.3 of the Agreement are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows:

1. Performance Metric #1: For the 2023-2024 school year, there shall have been issued at least 300 certifications in K-5 digital tools, 50 certifications in grades 6 - 8 digital tools, 30 certifications in HVAC, and 30 certifications in Automotive.

2. Performance Metric #2: Between the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year and the end of the 2023-2024 school year, in the aggregate at least seventy percent

(70%) of those enrolled in the K-5 digital tools, grades 6 - 8 digital tools, HVAC, and Automotive certification program actually complete the program and obtain a certificate.
