RE: Triumph Pre-Application No. 348 – Water & Wastewater Elevated Generators

Mr. Sears,

Thank you for submitting a Pre-Application to Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc.

Based on an initial review by the staff of Triumph Gulf Coast, Inc., ("TGC") and a concurrence of the Board, your proposal does not appear to be statutorily eligible to receive funding as presented. The preapplication requests 100% of the funds for the purchase and installation of three permanent standby generators and elevating them above floodplain with the bottom of the generators at approximately elevation 12 feet.

According to Florida Statute 288.8071(3) awards may not be used to finance 100 percent of any project or program and an award may not supplant existing funding sources. Because the requested Triumph funds were stated to be for 100% of the cost of the generators and it is not clear that this does not supplant utility operation costs, the pre-application does not appear to be eligible at this time.

This is an initial opinion based only on your pre-application and is not intended to be any sort of final action by TGC. Further, despite the reservations set forth herein, you may choose to submit a formal Application or a revised Pre-Application.

Triumph Gulf Coast funding is intended to support programs that generate maximum economic activity. Applicants have asked how best to document the economic activity that would likely result from their proposed project. At the January 2018 Triumph Board of Directors meeting, Dr. Rick Harper discussed characteristics most often associated with higher levels of economic activity. These factors include things like amount of matching funds, and whether the project will become self-sustaining as Triumph dollars are used up.
